


Term	Definition	Image
Low vision	Significantly reduced vision that cannot be fully restored with treatment or prescription glasses. A person with low vision can see some things, but usually finds it hard to learn or carry out tasks without the help of low vision assistive products.	
Low vision assistive products	Support people with low vision to carry out tasks. Include optical devices (magnifiers and telescopes); and non-optical devices (such as large print, reading stands, and other adaptations to the environment).	
Magnification power	How much bigger an object appears when magnified. A magnification power of 5X means the magnifier makes the object appear five times larger than it is.	
Field of view	The area that a person can see.	
Focusing	Finding the point where an image is clear.	
Localising an object	Finding and focusing on an object.	
Tracking an object	Watching an object as it moves.
