




Term	Definition	Image
<b>Field of view</b>	The area that a person can see.	
<b>Focusing</b>	Finding the point where an image is clear.	
<b>Localising an object</b>	Finding and focusing on an object.	
<b>Low vision</b>	Significantly reduced vision that cannot be fully restored with treatment or prescription spectacles. A person with low vision can see some things, but usually finds it hard to learn or carry out tasks without the help of low vision assistive products.	
<b>Low vision assistive products</b>	Support people with low vision to carry out tasks. Include optical devices (magnifiers and telescopes); and non-optical devices (such as large print, reading stands, and other adaptations to the environment).	
<b>Magnification power</b>	How much bigger an object appears when magnified. A magnification power of 5x means the magnifier makes the object appear five times larger than it is.	
<b>Tracking an object</b>	Watching an object as it moves.
